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Introduction

This guide is intended to help identify the various Ford Flathead Distributors, the differences between them and how they can be swapped out between different years of the Ford Flathead engine.

Ford Flathead Helmet Distributor Reference

Year: 1932-1936 Helmet (1st release). **3 screw coil** with **3 bolt mounting**. Note Mounting Holes appear to be a different pattern than the 1937 -1941 **2 screw coil** distributor, but the mounting remains the same and the distributors are interchangeable between 1932 to 1941.



Year: 1937 -1941 Helmet (2nd Release) **2 screw coil with 3 bolt mounting.** Will interchange with earlier distributors. Note: There is one unused hole on this design.

To adapt these distributors to a later '42 to '48 Flathead you need the 'Button' to make up the difference for the shorter cam. Vintage Auto Garage PN 91012710



Ford Flathead Crab or Pancake Distributor Reference

Year: 1942-1948 Pancake or "Crab" Distributor, named for the early 1 piece "Crab" cap, but also came later on with the 2 Piece Cap as shown below

To adapt the 2 Bolt, to the 3 Bolt, a space is needed for the longer drive snout Speedway PN 9103241

Ford Flathead Distributor Reference – Long Camshaft Notes

Early Long Camshaft or Aftermarket Long Camshaft installed in a Late 1942-1948 Flathead, where the Factory had a Short Camshaft in place. Note: Not a common circumstance.

The 2 Bolt "Crab" Distributor will need a spacer plate to **push the distributor out**, to accommodate the Long or Aftermarket Cam. This applies to either the Crab or 2 Piece Cap (same distributor, different cap).
